

PROTECTION FOR BONDS AND BUSINESSES AT H & H SECURITY

CAN THERE BE ENOUGH SECURITY in today's environment for families, businesses and organizations? The families and friends of the stricken victims at Virginia Tech would surely say no. It is a dangerous and uncertain world and the need for security service is at an all-time high.

People unfamiliar with the bond process often assume that everyone shows up for trial after a bond has been posted. But one third of all released defendants were subsequently rearrested for a new offense, failed to appear in court as scheduled or committed another violation that resulted in the revocation of their pretrial release. This means whoever posted the bond is out of luck – and a lot of money. H & H Security is the only trained and licensed bail enforcement

agency in the area. The company has complied with strict regulations and certifications prescribed by Virginia law and the Department of Criminal Justice Services.

"We are able to accommodate the needs of our clients in a number of ways," Howard stated. "Once we assess the situation, we tailor a program of security for the client."

"We recently had a client, a woman who had posted bail, who had a strong feeling her husband wanted to jump bail," Rod stated. "In that event, she would have lost her bail money, a significant sum. The woman called us and we found her husband and returned him to jail so he would stand trial."

Howard went on to say that of the 22% of released defendants who had a bench warrant issued for their arrest because they did not appear in court as scheduled, about one-fourth of that number were still fugitives after one year.

Rod Howard has lived in Charlottesville for 38 years and has been a business owner here for the past 20 years. He has been in the security business since 1989. With many connections in various police departments and other security agencies, Howard has access to a large network of security people, able to provide protection for companies, individuals and sponsors for a variety of events.
